Duties and Responsibilities:

➤ Chairing the Council Youth Network

3. Ensure the Public Appointment Process and other Scouts Canada policies are followed by the Council Youth Network.
4. Appoint and mentor Deputy Council Youth Commissioners.
5. In coordination with the Deputy Council Youth Commissioners continue to build the direction of the Council Youth Network.

➤ Member of Council Key 3

1. Work as an active and equal member of the Council Key 3 to create the roadmap and yearly plan for council.
2. Actively participate with the Council Leadership Team and Council Service Team to create a better youth led Scouting experience for youth.
3. Seek out new opportunities and partnerships to enhance the image and program for scouting.
4. Ensure the youth perspective is given in decisions made by the Council Key 3.
5. Align the direction of the council plan with the direction of the Council Youth Network.
